This is why Christians are called to boldly proclaim that Jesus IS Good News and that Easter is the season of hope.

LIBRARY NEWS

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is well underway once again, with many students at Mazenod registering and already entering books onto the website. In past years, the Challenge has proven valuable in encouraging students to develop the habit of reading for enjoyment while also assisting families in supporting their children's reading in and beyond school. It is not a competitive event but rather one that emphasises individual challenge and participation.

To complete the challenge, participants read 15 books between the start of Term 1 and the beginning of September. In Years 7-9, participants must read 10 or more books from the Challenge list, and in Year 10 they must read 5 or more. The remainder can be the reader's own choice. Printed lists are available in the Library as well as online at the Challenge website <http://www.education.vic.gov.au/prc/>. Registration forms can be collected from the Library. On registration each participant will be emailed a username and password to log on to the VPRC website so that they can record their reading. Also on the website are student and celebrity reviews of popular books on the Challenge list.
