### Instructions:

1. Staple to inside front page of book (top right hand corner) Include the selling price of the text. (The seller's price is their decision and books that are a dollar or so below the suggested prices move the quickest.)  
It is essential to include (print clearly) your student ID number. Please do not send books that are not on the list eg. Study Guides.
2. Book sales dates:

Year 12 texts for 2015 – Mon 24 <sup>th</sup> Nov	(12.30 – 2.00pm)	(10 Ryan)
Year 11 texts for 2015 – Mon 1 <sup>st</sup> Dec	(12.30 – 2.00pm)	(10 Lombard)
Year 10 texts for 2015 – Thurs 27 <sup>th</sup> Nov	(12.30 – 2.00pm)	(10 Ryan)
Year 7 – 9 texts for 2015 – Saturday 29 <sup>th</sup> Nov	(8.30am – 10.30am)	(10 Ryan)
3. Money for book sales will be credited to family accounts during Term 1 2015.  
For students leaving the College a cheque will be posted home.
4. For Years 10, 11 and 12 sales, students will be invited to purchase books in small numbers and are not permitted in 10 Ryan/Lombard unless supervised by a staff member.
5. Books (Yr 12) be handed in at Reception / Student counter no later than Fri 21<sup>st</sup> Nov  
Books (Yr 11) be handed in at Reception / Student counter no later than Weds 26<sup>th</sup> Nov  
Books (Yr 10) be handed in at Reception / Student counter no later than Weds 26<sup>th</sup> Nov  
Books (Yrs 7 –9) in the Year level coordinator's office no later than Friday 28<sup>th</sup> Nov.
6. The Fathers' Association is organising the sales and will be charging 10% to the seller of the books.
7. Unsold Years 11 & 12 books will be available for collection first week back Term 1 2015. If required earlier than that they may be collected by appointment.  
The students in Years 7-10 will be given the unsold books back during the last week of school.
8. **Families can sell and buy books online using the “Mazbay” service. Brochures on how to use Mazbay can be collected from the student counter. Mazbay proved a very convenient way for many families to purchase and sell books last year.**
9. Publishers' conditions regarding digital resources vary, eg. Jacaranda charge 33% of the original cost for the purchasing of the digital material for the second and third year. Many students have purchased second hand and have not reactivated ebooks. Please check MazBay for ebook reactivation costs and conditions.
